


Synonym: Outer Covering The natural outer layer of tissue that covers the body of a person or animal


Skin

Skin is an <u>organ</u> that has functions.




Synonym: body part A part of the body that has a particular function

Skin is an organ that protects human body systems.


Types of organs: Skin, heart, lungs, liver, brain



Functions of Skin

Support, Protection, Movement,

Skin supports the human body by covering all human body systems such as the skeletal and muscular systems.



Skin protects the human body systems from harmful substances and germs.



Skin covers the muscular system and skeletal system allowing the human body to move.



Skin has <u>nerve receptors</u> that provide information about external conditions. (Sense of touch hot vs. cold)
